INTENTION BEHIND THIS TALK

A SAD PARADOX

- Several books on action research, including handbooks for practitioners, are published by for-profit publishers (Sage, Springer, etc.) at a very high price.
- Therefore, these books are not accessible to civil society organizations, non-university workers or activists, even non-funded academics - which is a sad paradox for people hoping to co-construct knowledge or do it in a participatory way.
- I want to raise awareness about the benefits of **open access** books among action research practitioners and authors hoping to change society.

FIRST PURPOSE OF OPEN ACCESS

Improve the productivity of research and researchers

- Eysenbach (2006) : Since open access maximises the number of quotations, it « is likely to benefit science by accelerating dissemination and uptake of research findings ».
- The quicker the results are disseminated, the quicker research advances, the more scientists publish and the more their career prosper
- Journals are managers of this incessant flux of results and papers.

SECOND PURPOSE OF OPEN ACCESS

- A mainly economic purpose : « Open Access to science and data = cash and economic bonanza », according to Neelie Kroes (2013), Vice-president of the european community en 2013
- OECD is for open access since it increases the potentialities for innovation : « avoiding duplication while facilitating replication, accelerating discovery, and driving innovation ».
- Innovation that can be tranformed into merchandise, markets.

THIRD PURPOSE OF OPEN ACCESS

- **Democratization of access to scientific knowledge for people without an affiliation to a university:**
 - K-12 teachers
 - Non-professional science lovers
 - Civil society organizations
 - Journalists
 - Public administrations
 - Graduates wishing to continue to learn and think
- From a fiscal justice viewpoint, open access gives back to tax-payers what they funded through their taxes.

OPEN ACCESS ACCORDING TO THE BUDAPEST INITIATIVE (2002)

By “open access” to [peer-reviewed research literature], we mean its free availability on the public internet, permitting any users to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles, crawl them for indexing, pass them as data to software, or use them for any other lawful purpose, without financial, legal, or technical barriers other than those inseparable from gaining access to the internet itself.

The only constraint on reproduction and distribution, and the only role for copyright in this domain, should be to give authors control over the integrity of their work and the right to be properly acknowledged and cited.

HOW TO MAKE « OPEN ACCESS »

- Two possibilities for researchers:
 - Publish in an open access journal or publishing house
 - Archive one's papers or books in an institutional repository (website)
 - Reminder : open access journals do practice peer review and can have impact factor if it is what counts...
- Problem : For-profit publishers have started to make authors pay for open access (since readers should not pay anymore) : it has (wrongly) disgusted scientists from open access, deemed very expensive...
- But it is only 30-40% of the journals.
- All other journals do not make authors pay
- Beware of a new enclosure!


